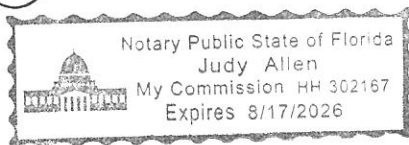

The successful bidder will be required to provide unarmed uniformed security services with a company marked vehicle for the parking garage.
