A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF NEW PORT RICHEY, FLORIDA PROVIDING FOR THE NAMING OF CERTAIN ALLEY RIGHTS-OF-WAY IN THE CITY, AS PROVIDED HEREIN.

WHEREAS, the City has received citizen and resident input on the naming of alley rights-of-way in the City; and

WHEREAS, the naming of alley rights-of-way improves the character of the City and is a benefit to all citizens and residents of the City; and

WHEREAS, the attached map establishes the names for each alley right-of-way to be named as set forth therein and each existing numerical alley designation for each; and

WHEREAS, the City Council hereby finds that this Resolution is in the best interests of the health, safety and welfare of the citizens of the City.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the City Council of the City of New Port Richey, Florida, that the attached alley name map is hereby approved and adopted, and each alley right-of-way segment set forth therein shall hereafter be referred to and named as identified in said map.

IT IS FURTHER RESOLVED that the City Manager is hereby authorized to place such signs as deemed necessary to identify the alley rights-of-way consistent with this Resolution.

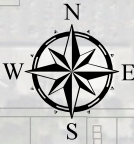
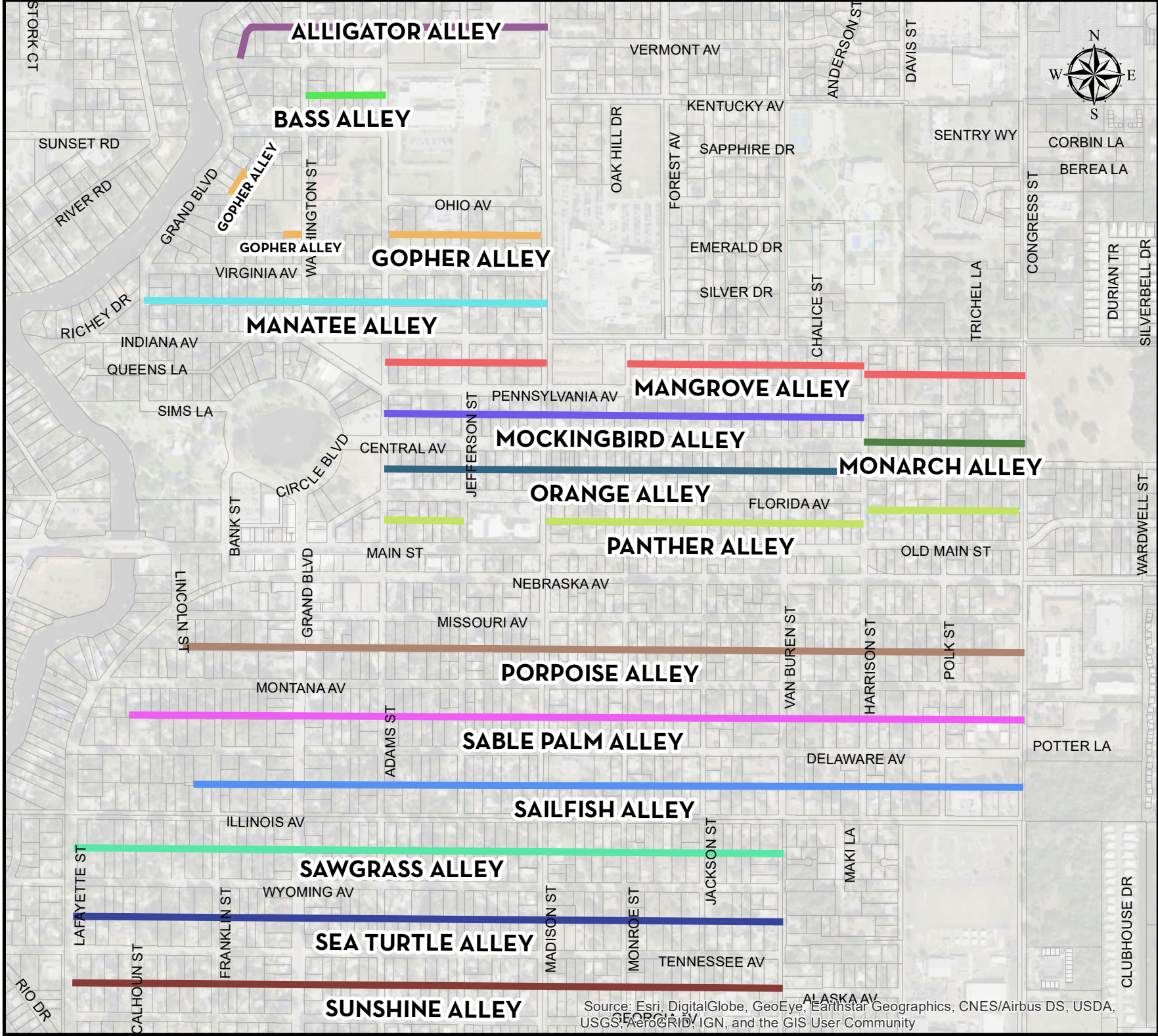
