PARKS & RECREATION BOARD MEETING

September 8, 2015

Greg Giordano called the regular meeting of the Parks & Recreation Advisory Board to order at 7:30 a.m. on Tuesday, September 8, 2015. Board Members Betty Black, Joy Phillips, and staff liaison Elaine Smith were also in attendance. There was not a quorum and the August meeting minutes were not able to be voted on for approval.

OLD BUSINESS:

- Youth Focus Group We had a group of about 20 children ages 3-11
 years attend to preview features of the new Sims Park playground; they
 voted on their interest in those features (shown in 1-minute segments on
 the movie screen in the gymnasium); some pictures were published in the
 Suncoast News.
- Sims Park Project Up-date Playground and Fit Zone are ready to be ordered; prep work for sidewalks and at retention pond is continuing from last week; Pavers and Roadway meeting this Thursday.
- Recreation & Aquatic Center Up-date There will be a meeting this week to discuss the plan for the facility.
- Nature Coast Home Show We had people lined up outside before the
 doors opened; the event organizer and vendors were very happy with the
 attendance. The NPR City booth represented Economic Development,
 Parks & Recreation, Public Works, and Development Services to let those
 in the community know what is available to them; programs for
 homeowners. Small tool boxes and paint brushes were given out.
- Kayak Launch Agenda item for City Council meeting next week; have enough funding for the Grey Preserve; should be completed by November, 2015.
- Small Library Box suggestion for people to be able to read in the Park; passed idea on to the Library Director
- August Pool Party Had good attendance; 234 participants
