RESOLUTION BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF NEW PORT RICHEY,
FLORIDA, ADOPTING THE PASCO COUNTY COMPREHENSIVE EMERGENCY
MANAGEMENT PLAN.

WHEREAS, Florida Administrative Rule 9G-6 establishes the criteria for review of local emergency management plans; and

WHEREAS, the "Local Comprehensive Emergency Management Plan Compliance Criteria" which is adopted by reference in Rule 9G-6, sets forth the criteria and format for local emergency management plans; and

WHEREAS, Section 252.38(2), Florida Statutes, provides that "Municipalities without emergency management programs shall be served by their respective county agencies"; and

WHEREAS, the Pasco County Comprehensive Emergency Management Plan has been reviewed by the State of Florida, Division of Emergency Management, and declared to be in compliance with the terms of Chapter 9G-6.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED, that the City of New Port Richey, a Florida municipal corporation, through its City Council, in regular session assembled this date, does hereby declare that the Pasco County Comprehensive Emergency Management Plan is adopted and authorized to be activated by the City of New Port Richey.
