Case: Code Amendment COD2017-07 – Repealing Mobile Vending Regulations

Request: Review and recommendation of an amendment to the Land Development Code repealing the mobile vending regulations (Ordinance #2012-2127)

Ms. Lindquist said the ordinance before the Board members repeals the mobile vending regulations in anticipation of the City adopting new regulations regulating mobile vending. Mr. Driscoll explained that it is not appropriate for mobile vending regulations to be part of the Land Development Code.

Mr. Smallwood asked about the existing hot dog vendor near Sims Park. Ms. Fierce explained that the vendor is governed by the existing sidewalk vendor ordinance and in the future they will be governed by the new mobile vending ordinance. Ms. Fierce said that vendor parking will also be regulated by the new ordinance.

Ms. MacDonald made a motion to recommend approval of the repeal. Mr. Parrillo seconded the motion. Roll call vote: Ms. MacDonald, yes; Mr. Smith, yes; Mr. Parrillo, yes; Dr. Cadle, yes; and Mr. Smallwood, yes. The motion passed (5-0).
