



City of New Port Richey Sculpture Exhibit

Theme: Happiness Is...

Professional and amateur sculptors are invited to submit entries for the City of New Port Richey's annual outdoor sculpture exhibit.

Eight sculptors will be chosen, by a panel of judges, to display their artwork in beautiful downtown New Port Richey for a period of 12 months.

All artwork selected for the 2020-2021 exhibition will be photographed and may be used in future marketing or promotional material by the Cultural Affairs Committee and/or the City of New Port Richey.

There is no fee to enter, and each artist, whose sculpture is chosen, will receive a \$750 stipend to cover transportation, installation and removal of artwork. After installation and passing the safety inspection, the artist will receive \$450. The remaining \$300 will be paid to the artist upon timely removal of the sculpture (within two weeks of exhibit closing date).

Application Form

1. Artists may enter a total of two sculptures for consideration.
2. Sculptures must be suitable for outdoor public display and able to withstand the environment (sun, wind, rain and inquisitive children and people).
3. Completed applications, including images and attachments, are to be forwarded by postal mail or email (uploads will be accepted as PDF or JPEG)

5. If you wish to have your support material returned, include a self-addressed, stamped envelope or appropriate postage/packaging for safe return.
6. Please provide ALL required information as incomplete or poorly presented applications cannot be considered.
7. Entries without photographs will not be considered.
8. Late applications will not be accepted or considered.
9. Note: Placement of sculptures will be allocated by the Cultural Affairs Committee.

Installation

- Installation of sculptures must not affect the environment or the path (rocks, trees, bark and the indigenous plants)
- Responsibility for installation and removal is that of each artist. Please come prepared with tools and any assistance needed. Electricity is not available at the installation location.
- If assistance is required to lift and/or move a sculpture into position, it is the responsibility of the artist to notify the Cultural Affairs Committee before installation, and to book an installation time. (Please state on the Entry Form if a forklift is required).
- A safety inspection of each sculpture must be completed and approved.
- Artists may be required to make some immediate changes to comply with safety guidelines. All changes or modifications must be addressed and fixed by the artist prior to leaving the sculpture and receiving initial payment of \$450.

Awards

A total of four cash prizes will be awarded as follows:

Judge's Award Winners: 1st Place \$1000. 2nd Place \$500.

City Council's Award Winners: 1st Place \$1000. 2nd Place \$500.

Declaration

I understand that the Cultural Affairs Committee has the right to promptly remove the sculpture, after artist notification, if any safety hazards are found or damage occurs.

I understand that all sculptures are exhibited at the artist's own risk. The Cultural Affairs Committee and the City of New Port Richey will not accept responsibility for any loss or damage to artwork.
