RE: Auction Vehicles

Currently, the City has seven (7) vehicles stored at the Fleet Maintenance Garage. All of these vehicles were identified by the Fleet Maintenance Supervisor or Department Head to have out lived their usefulness due to wear and tear or high mileage.

There are multiple ways of selling these vehicles; in the past the City has elected to pay a percentage of the funds collected to the vendor assisting in the sale of the City vehicles and equipment. I believe with the current budget constraints facing the City, the Fleet Maintenance Division should perform an auction in-house. With the assistance of Public Surplus, a web base public, Auction House, all proceeds collected from the auction would belong to the City with the exception of advertizing. Public Surplus worked very well for the City in the past auction.
