All violations of the New Port Richey Land Development Code and the New Port Richey Code of Ordinances not otherwise designated below shall be deemed to be a Class V offense.

Fines may be doubled for a second offense and for each subsequent offense thereafter. Third and subsequent offenses and other certain violations posing a serious threat to public health, safety, or welfare may require a mandatory court appearance.
