Re: ITB20-006 WWTF Storage Tank Cleaning and Painting Bid

Robert,

Attached for your review and City Council consideration is a proposal to paint the Wastewater Treatment Plants: 2-Reuse tanks & 4-Aeration tanks This is a budgeted capital expense.

Background:

The WWTP Facility has many above ground concrete treatment tanks that require periodic maintenance. The coatings on these tanks must be kept up to protect the structures from decay. The tanks were last painted nearly fourteen years ago. On December 13th 2019 bids were opened for Storage Tank Cleaning and Painting Bid. The bid tabulation is shown below. 3 out of the 9 bids had the required QP1 qualification
