

ORDINANCE NO. 2020-2180

**AN ORDINANCE OF THE CITY OF NEW RICHEY, FLORIDA
PROVIDING FOR REPEAL OF ORDINANCE NO. 2019-2155; AND
PROVIDING FOR AN EFFECTIVE DATE.**

WHEREAS, on November 5, 2019, the City Council adopted Ordinance No. 2019-2155, which granted approval of a conditional use for a scooter and one-wheel vehicle sales retail and rental store, known as “eCarve LLC”, located at 5780 Main Street; and

WHEREAS, on January 21, 2020, the City Council adopted Ordinance No. 2020-2177, which granted Scott Carbone, doing business as eCarve, LLC, a conditional use to operate a scooter and one-wheel sales retail and rental store at 5707 Main Street; and

WHEREAS, the Development Department has confirmed that eCarve, LLC is no longer operating out of 5780 Main Street and the Owner has consented to the repeal of Ordinance No. 2019-2155; and

WHEREAS, the City Council finds that it is in the best interest of the health, safety and welfare of the citizens of the City to repeal Ordinance No. 2019-2155 which granted the original approval.

**NOW, THEREFORE, THE CITY OF NEW PORT RICHEY, FLORIDA HEREBY
ORDAINS:**

SECTION I. Ordinance No. 2019-2155 is hereby repealed in its entirety.

SECTION II. This Ordinance shall become effective as provided by law.
