**1. Title: Climbing in Balance**

Steel extrusions and paint; 9' tall; \$6,000. Abstract.

This sculpture is based on the rebuilding of our economy. It shows a big mass of steel, climbing in balance, like the rough edges we have in life while working our way through them to find the higher beauty in everyday life.



**2. Title: Locomotion**

Steel, painted; 4' 5" tall; \$3,000. Abstract sculpture made out of railroad ties.



3. Title: **Don't Mess with My Feelings (Heart Sculpture)**  
\$7,000; stainless steel; 8' tall; \$7,000. Abstract.



4. Title: **I want to be a Butterfly**  
\$3,500; stainless steel, steel, and paint; 6' tall; \$3,500. Abstract and realism.



5. Title: **La Patrone**

Forged steel with I beam; 8'4" tall; \$8,000. Abstract and surrealism.

Forged steel with I beam; 7' tall ; \$8,000. Abstract and surrealism.
