

Cultural Affairs Committee Meeting

May 20, 2020

The regular meeting of the Cultural Affairs Committee was called to order in a virtual meeting by phone at 6:30pm on Wednesday, May 20, 2020. Board Members Chairman Richard Melton, Glenna Sumrall, Anna Mae McNally, Kelly Smallwood, Ruth Ann Jackson, Bryan Cartwright, Lisa Marie Dolcy, and staff liaison Elaine Smith were in attendance.

APPROVAL OF MINUTES:

- The Minutes from the February 19, 2020 meeting were unanimously approved.

OLD BUSINESS:

- Sculpture Walk Update – There was discussion about the Sculpture Walk proposal that was rejected by City Council. Q-Is it possible to do another proposal? Q-Is it possible to do another “Call to Artists”? The CAC voted unanimously to have the Sculpture Walk put back on a City Council Agenda, at a date that the meetings are open to the public or when a representative from the CAC is allowed to attend the meeting. They want to provide images of sculptures displayed at area sculpture walks, as well as have some of the art from the local artist that was presented this month, revisited for consideration.
- Museum Work Session – June 16th, 2020: 6:00pm – There was discussion about the CAC being unable to attend the Work Session. They voted unanimously to be able to have a representative attend the June 16th Work Session on Museums or to have the work session be re-scheduled to a future date when a CAC representative may attend. (It was later discovered that this work session is about the Historical Society Museum and it will continue on June 16th)

VOX POP:

The next CAC meeting is scheduled for June 17th, 2020. Hopefully we can meet in person (group of 10 or fewer), and stay 6’ apart. Everyone has the option to call in to the meeting.

Let's decide at the next meeting if the CAC is going to meet or skip a month over the summer. (Put on the Agenda)
