Dear Ms. Manns:

The purpose of this letter is to inform you that Pasco County has adopted an updated Comprehensive Emergency Management Plan (CEMP). As you know, municipalities have to adopt this plan if they do not have their own and all municipalities must be covered by a CEMP in order for Pasco County to be eligible to receive federal mitigation funds.

The Pasco County Comprehensive Emergency Management Plan represents an all-hazards, whole community approach to Emergency Management and is required by FAC 27P-6. The plan is meant to reinforce Pasco County's commitment to working with municipal partners in all aspects of the emergency management cycle and does not supersede any local emergency response plans. The plan has been reviewed by FDEM and found to be in compliance with this rule and aligns with the Florida State Comprehensive Emergency Management Plan.

Pasco County Emergency Management requests that the City of New Port Richey adopt the 2020 CEMP via resolution. A sample resolution and the 2020 Comprehensive Emergency Management Plan have been included with this letter.
