

## **Cultural Affairs Committee Meeting**

March 17, 2021

### APPROVAL OF MINUTES:

- February 17, 2021 – The Minutes were unanimously approved.

### VOX POP:

- The Bike Rack should be completed and installed in two weeks.
- The Mural Ordinance revisions are on the Agenda for City Council on April 20<sup>th</sup>, 2021.

### OLD BUSINESS:

- Investigation Station – Geological Timeline (Presentation) – Lisa Campos gave a presentation on how to create a hands-on exhibit along the Cotee River front with a dozen stopping points, showing the geological development of Florida and its inhabitants' natural evolution across the ages. The geo-app costs about \$15K-20K. These stations would have a multi-facet component; Hands-on, listening, and the app. Initially, Lisa expressed interest in having the CAC decide stations. However, it was determined by the CAC members that they do not have enough information to decide which stations. Rich suggested that Lisa meet up with Charles Zidar, from MAPS at Wyndall Krynn HS. The CAC would like to have Lisa meet back up with the CAC in a couple of months for an update.

NEW BUSINESS:

- Sculpture Walk – Applications from Artists – There were several sculptures and a few applications passed around to review for consideration.
- Committee for Public Art Fund Ordinance – There was some discussion amongst the CAC members.
- Selfie World Tampa – There was some discussion amongst the CAC members.
- Murals – What Now? – The CAC wants to take a field trip to look at Murals in other local towns/cities.
