APPROVAL OF MINUTES:

- March 17, 2021 – The Minutes were unanimously approved. (There was no quorum in April or May, 2021.)

OLD BUSINESS:

- Mural Ordinance Update – The CAC would like to get a copy from the LDR Board.
- Sculpture Walk Update – \$ from the Public Art Fund will be used to make a Sculpture Walk.

NEW BUSINESS:

- Graeme Currie – Hometown the Musical Budget – (The budget for the play was distributed.) Expenses were reduced to \$5750.00. Glena proposed the CAC donate \$2,300.00 toward the project (pending review of the budget). A motion was made, but there was no 2nd; there was not enough support from the committee at this time. Rich requested that the CAC budget be provided at every meeting.
- Investigation Station Update – Lisa Campos gave an update on the status of the project. She had met with Chopper Davis who suggested the River Walk area. 10 different stations would be provided, from the beginning of the formation of Florida to its current state. There would be inter-active geological information at each station using puzzles, mosaics, fossils, and other hands-on exhibits. The cost of the project is still unknown, but if anyone is able to offer assistance, they are encouraged to contact Lisa.
