**ARTICLES OF INCORPORATION
OF
FARRELL CARES, INC.
a Florida non-profit corporation**

ARTICLE I. - NAME

The name of this Corporation shall be **FARRELL CARES, INC.**

ARTICLE II. - PURPOSE

This Corporation is organized under the not for profit corporation laws of the State of Florida, exclusively for secular, non-political, not for profit, charitable, cultural and educational purposes, to promote the welfare of and to help the local community, which not for profit is located within the State of Florida, including, but not limited to, Pasco, Pinellas, Hillsborough, and Hernando Counties, and to further promote fund raising activities and the solicitation of donations for the purpose of providing funds, services and support for the local community, the making of distributions to organizations that qualify as exempt organizations described under Section 501(c)(3) of the Internal Revenue Code, or corresponding section of any future federal tax code.

The Association will make no distribution of income to its members.

ARTICLE III. - EXISTENCE & COMMENCEMENT

This Corporation shall have perpetual existence and its existence shall have commenced upon the filing of the Articles of Incorporation with the Secretary of State of the State of Florida.

ARTICLE IV. - PRINCIPAL OFFICE

The street address of the initial principal office of the Corporation shall continue to be: **6835 Commerce Avenue, Port Richey, FL 34668**, and its mailing address shall be: **PO Box 776 Port Richey, FL 34673**.

ARTICLE V. - REGISTERED AGENT & ADDRESS

The name and address of the initial registered agent of this Corporation shall continue to be:

ARTICLE VI. - DIRECTORS and OFFICERS

The affairs of the Corporation will be managed by a Board of Directors. The number of members of the Board of Directors will be determined by the bylaws of the Corporation. The number of Directors may be either increased or diminished from time to time by the bylaws, but shall never be less than three. The method of election of the Directors shall be as provided in the bylaws of the Corporation. The Board of Directors may appoint Officers in accordance with the bylaws of the Corporation.

ARTICLE VII. - INDEMNITY OF OFFICERS & DIRECTORS

The Corporation shall indemnify any officer or director to the full extent permitted by law.

ARTICLE IX.

No part of the net earnings of the Corporation shall inure to the benefit of, or be distributable to its members, trustees, officers, or other persons (except that the corporation shall be authorized and empowered to pay reasonable compensation for services rendered and to make payments and distributions in furtherance of the purposes set forth in Article Three hereof). No substantial part of the activities of the corporation shall be the carrying on of propaganda, or otherwise attempting to influence legislation, and the corporation shall not participate in, or intervene in (including the publishing or distribution of statements) any political campaign on behalf of or in opposition to any candidate for public office. Notwithstanding any other provision of these Articles, the Corporation shall not carry on any other activities not permitted to be carried on (a) by a corporation exempt from federal income tax under section 501(c)(3) of the Internal Revenue Code, or the corresponding section of any future federal tax code, or (b) by a corporation, contributions to which are deductible under section 170 (c)(2) of the Internal Revenue Code, or the corresponding section of any future federal tax code.

ARTICLE X.

Upon the dissolution of this Corporation, assets shall be distributed for one or more exempt purposes within the meaning of Section 501(c)(3) of the Internal Revenue Code (or corresponding section

of any future tax code), or shall be distributed to the federal government, or to a state or local government, for a public purpose. Any such assets not so disposed of shall be disposed by the Court of competent jurisdiction of the county in which the principal office of the Corporation is then located, exclusively for such purposes or to such Corporation or Corporations, as said Court shall determine, which are organized and operated exclusively for such purposes.

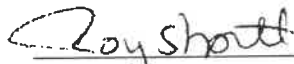

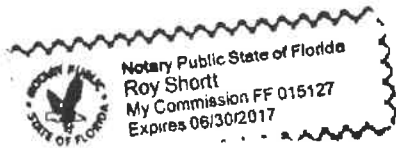
