

RESOLUTION NUMBER 2022-11

**A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY OF NEW PORT RICHEY OF PASCO COUNTY, FLORIDA,
ADOPTING THE TENTATIVE LEVYING OF AD VALOREM TAXES FOR PASCO COUNTY FOR FISCAL YEAR
2022-2023; PROVIDING AN EFFECIVE DATE**

WHEREAS, the City of New Port Richey of Pasco, Florida, on August 2, 2022, adopted a Fiscal Year 2022-2023 Tentative Millage Rate, as required by Florida Statute 200.065; and

WHEREAS, the gross taxable value for operating purposes not exempt from taxation within Pasco County has been certified by the County Property Appraiser for the City of New Port Richey as \$843,852,476; and

WHEREAS, the public hearing on establishment of the final millage rate will be held on Tuesday, September 15, 2022 at 6 pm in the City Council Chambers at 5919 Main Street, New Port Richey, FL 34652.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the City of New Port Richey of Pasco County, Florida, that:

1. The FY 2022-2023 tentative operating millage rate is 8.5000 mills, which is lower than the rolled-back rate of 8.5694 mills by .81%.
2. The City Council authorizes the notification of the Pasco County Property Appraiser of the tentative millage rate of 8.5000 mills and for use in the Truth in Millage Notices.
3. This Resolution will take effect immediately upon its adoption.
