

RESOLUTION NUMBER 2022-13

A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY OF NEW PORT RICHEY, PASCO COUNTY, FLORIDA,
ADOPTING THE TENTATIVE LEVYING OF AD VALOREM TAXES FOR ALL NON-EXEMPT
REAL AND PERSONAL PROPERTY IN NEW PORT RICHEY, PASCO COUNTY, FLORIDA,
FOR FISCAL YEAR 2022-2023; PROVIDING FOR AN EFFECTIVE DATE.

WHEREAS, the City Council of the City of New Port Richey, Pasco County, Florida, on September 15, 2022, adopted Fiscal Year Tentative Millage Rate following a public hearing as required by Florida Statute 200.065; and

WHEREAS, the City Council of New Port Richey, Pasco County, Florida, held a public hearing as required by Florida Statutes 200.065; and

WHEREAS, the gross taxable value for operating purposes not exempt from taxation within the City of New Port Richey, Pasco County has been certified by the County Property Appraiser to the City of New Port Richey as \$843,852,476.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED, by the City of New Port Richey, of Pasco County, Florida, that;

1. The FY 2022-2023 operating millage rate is 8.4500 mills, which is less than the rolled-back rate of 8.9148 mills by 5.50%.
2. There is no voted debt service millage.
3. The resolution will take effect immediately upon its adoption.
